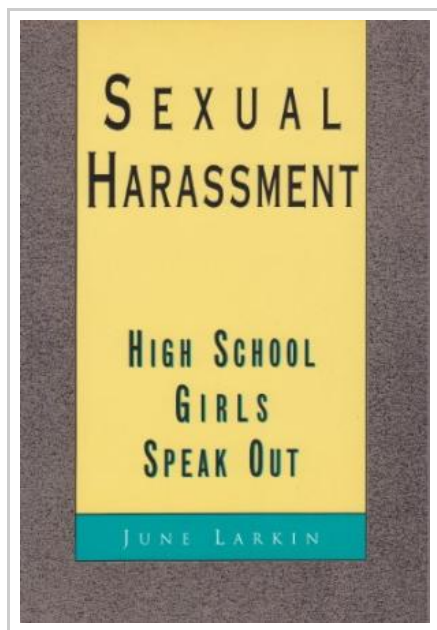




Sexual Harassment: High School Girls Speak Out (Paperback)
