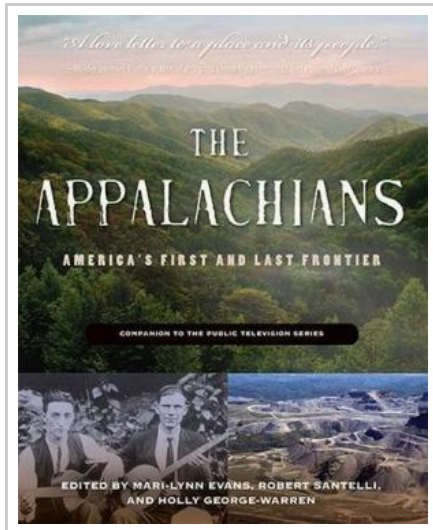




The Appalachians: America's First and Last Frontier (Paperback)
